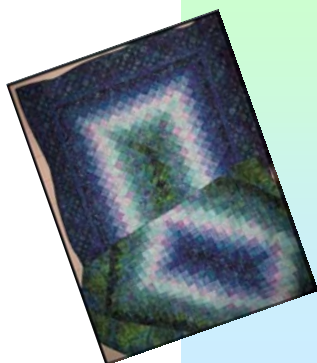
Trip for Two with Carol Kozlowski and Joanne Bradley

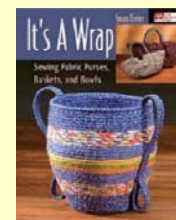

On-Point Class

In this class Sharon discusses how to put those "block-of-the-month" blocks together in an "on point" fashion. She will demonstrate this technique and answer questions you may have. Bring blocks you would like to talk about. *No sewing class*. Notebook and pencil suggested. \$15

Hand Quilting for Beginners

Sunday February 22 1:00 - 4:00

This class is for those who have always wanted to try hand quilting, but were not sure how to begin. Bring a "practice piece" being either a discarded block or a small quilt that you have backing and batting for. We will discuss how to mark, when to baste, what needles & threads to use and more . . . Sharon will show you the notions she uses to create her hand quilted projects and will get you started on your way to finishing your quilted treasure. Welcome also are those who have started a hand quilted project, but need a "refresher". \$20

Class Policies

- > Registration may be made in person, telephone or on-line. Fees for classroom instruction do not include fabric, books or patterns unless otherwise stated.
- > In order to be considered registered for a class your class fee must be paid when you sign up. At that time you will receive a supply list and a receipt that entitles you to a 15% discount off all class related supplies.
- > As a courtesy to our teachers, if you elect to withdraw from a class less than 3 days prior to the beginning of the class your class fee will be non-refundable, unless your spot can be filled.
- > If you elect to withdraw from a class at least 7 days prior to the beginning of the class, you will receive a store credit.
- > In the event a class must be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or inclement weather, students will receive a full monetary refund.

Dream Landscapes:

Sunday, February 8 & 15 11:00 - 4:00

This is the class for you to create your dream landscape. The first day of the class we'll discuss materials, how to transfer the pattern and how to sew the background. Saturday, Jan. 24 10 to 3

This quarter we're featuring Jeri Kelly's 'no sew' appliqué kits. Choose your pattern and come to learn how to use the most popular fusibles. You'll learn tips to make it easier and have a chance to practice what you learn while putting together one of these little wall hangings. Pattern or Kit required. \$30 Beginner level class

Threadplay

Saturday Feb. 21, 10 to 3 pm

Raw edge appliqué is very appealing due to its simplicity and how fast it can be done. Most of us whip through fusing on the pieces to stop dead at finishing the edges. Join Carol as she teaches you the basics of threadplay. Not only does it finish the edges, but adds movement and depth to your quilt. We'll practice some and then tackle a small project. Pattern Required. \$30

Dimensional Appliqué

Thursday February 19 10:00 - 3:00

This wall hanging is a great beginner pattern for learning dimensional appliqué because the pieces are large. We'll make the flowers and leaves in class and discuss options for finishing flower centers and making twisted fabric stems. Pattern required. \$30

Beginning Quilt making to Advanced Beginner

Thursdays, February 26, March 5, 19 & 26 6:00 - 8:00

This is THE place to start and learn all the basic techniques or to improve upon what you already know. You will learn how to do accurate rotary cutting, strip piecing, chain sewing, machine piecing four patch blocks, sew blocks into rows, match seams perfectly, do straight line machine quilting and make the binding to finish your project. You will NOT be a beginner when you finish this lovely, 4-Patch lap quilt. Book required. \$50

Celtic Appliqué

Saturday, March 7 10:00 - 3:00

This small project makes a great gift and is perfect for learning the technique behind Celtic Appliqué. You will need to have your photo transferred to fabric. In class you will learn two methods of making bias tubes and how to weave the Celtic design. Pattern Required. Intermediate level class. \$30

Faux Woven Scarf

Thurs. February 12 11:00 – 1:00

This clever seed stitch scarf is knit lengthwise with built-in fringe. Class will focus on different cast—ons and bind—offs, and how to use them to enhance your knitting. Pattern included. \$15



Slip A Color Hat

Saturday January 17 10:00 – 2:00

This hat is not only beautiful, but it is a lot of fun to knit. It's a great project to learn an easy slip stitch method for experimenting with color. Kit available. Pattern required. \$15

Triangle Scarf

Saturday February 7 10:00 – 1:00

What a beautiful scarf and a fun way to learn how to do short rows. Once you get the hang of it, you will be surprised how quick this scarf is to make. Pattern included. \$10

Felted Mittens

It's mitten season!!!! Learn how to knit extra warm felted mittens with the 'magic loop' method or on two circulars – knitter's choice. Lots of knitting packed into these cozy, warm mittens! Continental Knitting

Thursday, February 5 4:30 to 6:30

Learn to knit in the Continental (also called "European") style. This class is designed for "throwers" who wish to add another knitting style to their repertoire. Many knitters find it faster than English-style knitting, more ergonomic, and less stressful on arthritic hands and wrists; and it is a convenient way to do stranded two-color knitting. We will work on basic knitting techniques. For experienced 'throwers'. Book suggested. \$15

Basic Beginner's Socks

Friday, Jan. 30, Feb. 13 & 27 11:00 – 1:00

Handmade socks are one of life's little luxuries. Make some for yourself or someone you love and understand firsthand why everyone else is making socks. We will start from the cast-on and work step-by-step through the heel to the toe, learning how to work with double pointed needles and sport-weight sock yarn. Pattern required. \$35





STITCHES

Thursday Jan. 22, Feb. 26, & March 26
10:00 – 12:00

This "block of the month" class is designed for beginning knitters and for anyone wanting to explore knitting techniques and stitch patterns. Skills learned in this class will help you gain confidence in all your knitting projects. Each month, we will knit a square featuring a new technique and/or stitch. Depending on your commitment, you will make a large pillow, a small throw, or a medium afghan. (Coasters and potholders may also be an option.) You must be comfortable knitting and purling. This will be an ongoing class with quarterly signups. Make-up classes will be scheduled once per quarter. Patterns included. \$35

Cabled Pillow
